## **ANGUILLA COVID-19 MARITIME ENTRY REGULATIONS 2021/2022**

Anguilla is open for yacht entry; applications are being dealt with on a case-by-case basis. All yachts must be represented by a local, licensed agent and are prohibited from entering Anguillan waters without pre-approval by the Health Department (Entry Portal), Chief of Police and the Agent.

### **PRE-ARRIVAL PROCEDURE**

- All adult visitors must be fully vaccinated by approved vaccines and must have received their last vaccination at least 21 days prior to arrival (exemption only for minors under 18yrs and pregnant women with supporting doctors' letter).
- Obtain travel authorization by applying online <https://escape.ivotanguilla.com>
- Everyone onboard must upload a negative rt-PCR test - The **only** test accepted is the **real time rt-PCR (polymerase chain reaction) from a nasopharyngeal swab**, test must be conducted **3-5 days before arrival**.

**SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS** – must be submitted to the local agent within 48hrs of arrival and are subject to approval

- Certificate of registration
- Crew & passenger manifest
- Proof of vaccination for **everyone** onboard, scanned copies of **guest** passports
- Signed port arrival document (supplied by agent)
- Maritime declaration of health
- Last port clearance (once available, no rush)

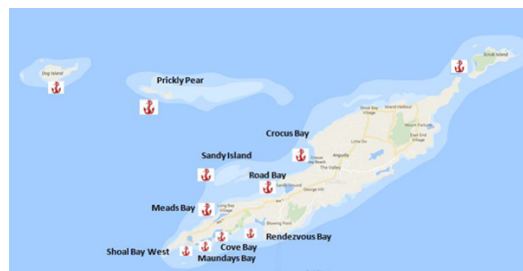
## ARRIVAL and ANGUILLA ACCESS

- Onboard rt-PCR testing on arrival for everyone onboard (Road Bay or Crocus Bay) by the local health team and on day 4 to release from quarantine. Costs us\$200/person
- Mandatory 4 day quarantine period will be extended to 10 days for fully vaccinated multi-generational families and unvaccinated children under the age of 18 years. This also applies if pregnant women are onboard
- Vessels are allowed to use all northern, government approved anchorages including the cays (see map below)

## ARRIVAL and ANCHOR ONLY

Offering vessels alternative, exciting anchorages and to give their guests an enhanced visual experience of Anguilla to add to their cruising itinerary - No coming ashore.

- Pre-Arrival procedure and supporting documents as above
- Vessels are allowed to use all northern, government approved anchorages including the cays. Please see map below



## DEPARTURE

It will be essential to coordinate charter itinerary well in advance, so that you are aware of entry requirements for the next port of call. Onward testing (PCR or Antigen) can be arranged within 48hrs notice, turnaround time for results 12-24hrs, depending lab load.

Please note, the situation is dynamic, the information is subject to change without notice.

## IMPORTANT COVID-19 TESTING INFORMATION

The ONLY accepted COVID-19 test is the real time rt-PCR (reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction) naso-pharyngeal swab

Additionally, tests with a minimum of two SARS-CoV-2 gene targets are strongly preferred

### COVID-19 Tests NOT Accepted

- Tests older than 5 days
- Tests taken the day before or two days before arrival
- Rapid tests – PCR or Antigen
- Antibody tests
- Sputum tests, AN tests or Oral Swab tests
- Home Testing kits
- Self-administered tests
- A doctor's cover letter will NOT be accepted in place of a laboratory test result certificate
