

2021/10/19 : MARTINIQUE IS OPEN TO TOURISM

1. FULLY VACCINATED VISITORS:

❖ FROM A GREEN COUNTRY :

Martinique is **OPEN** to any person coming from a **green country** (see list below) and possessing a **complete vaccination schedule**, i.e.:

- a. 7 days after the 2nd injection for double dose vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca),
- b. 4 weeks after injection for single dose vaccines (Johnson & Johnson),
- c. 7 days after injection of a vaccine in persons with a history of Covid-19 (only one dose required within 6 months of infection).
- d. Random virological testing may be requested upon arrival.

No PCR test or quarantine required.

NOTA: Vaccination is recommended from 12 years of age. However, unvaccinated minors may travel if accompanied by one or more vaccinated adults.

❖ FROM AN ORANGE OR RED COUNTRY:

In addition to a complete vaccination schedule, persons from an **orange** or **red** country will need to present a **negative PCR test** of less than 72 hours.

2. UNVACCINATED PERSONS - RESTRICTED VISITS:

These individuals are limited, based on the following conditions:

- a. Present a **COMPELLING REASON** to be declared (professional visits or any other reason that cannot be postponed (family, health...etc.)),
- b. Present a **NEGATIVE result** for a **PCR test** performed less than 72 hours before boarding, or of an **antigenic test** performed less than 48 hours before boarding.
- c. A random virological examination may be requested upon arrival.
- d. Observe a **QUARANTINE** for 7 days after arrival and perform a new virological screening test at the end of this period.

3. COUNTRIES ARE CLASSIFIED INTO 3 CATEGORIES: Green, Orange or Red

NOTA: The Caribbean islands are generally classified in **orange** status.

Classification of countries is based on health indicators (Status as of 10/14/2021 below).

- **"Green" countries:** countries and territories in which no active circulation of the virus has been observed and no variants of concern have been identified.

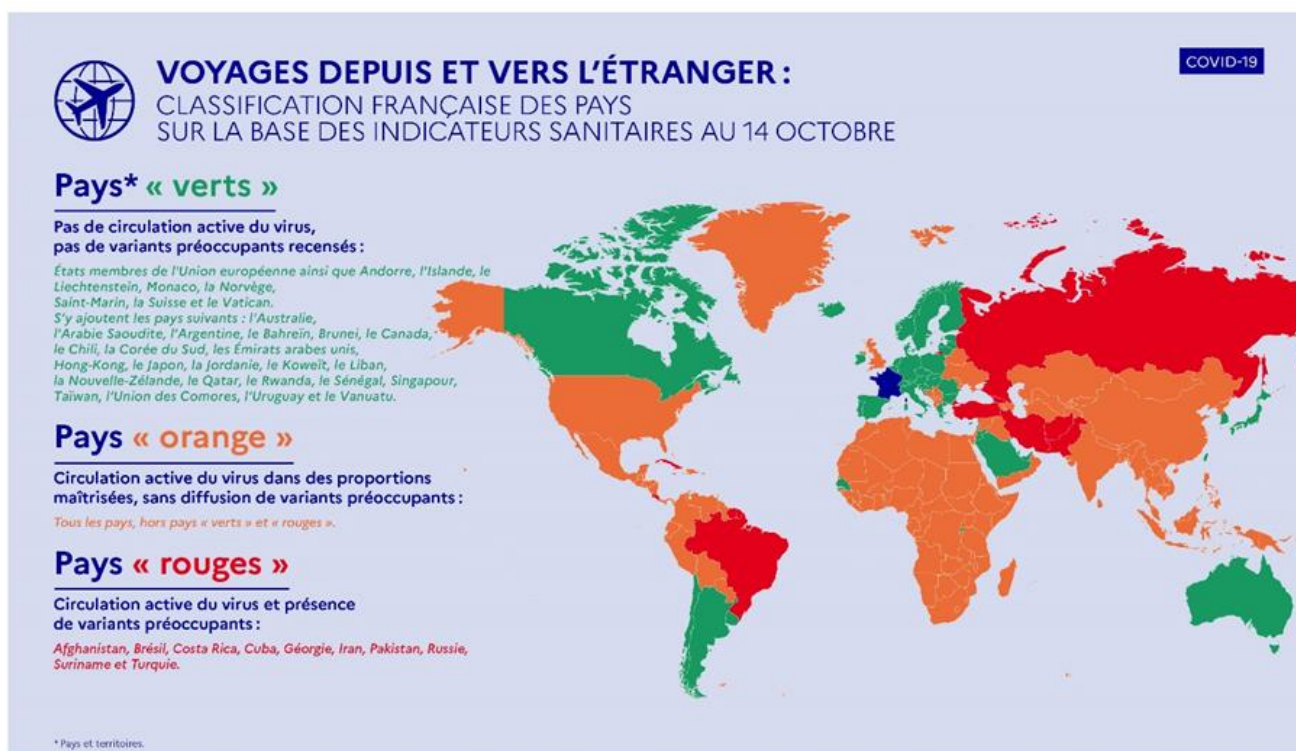
These are the countries of the European area, to which are added Australia, Saudi Arabia, Argentina, Bahrain, Brunei, Canada, Chile, South Korea, the United Arab Emirates, Hong Kong, Japan, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, New Zealand, Qatar, Rwanda, Senegal, Singapore, Taiwan, Union of the Comoros, Uruguay and Vanuatu.

- **"Orange" countries:** countries in which active circulation of the virus is observed in controlled proportions, without the dissemination of worrying variants.

These are all countries that are not included in the lists of "green" and "red" countries, for example the United Kingdom, for which an obligation of testing of less than 24 hours for unvaccinated people has been added.

- **"Red" countries:** countries in which an active circulation of the virus is observed with the presence of worrying variants.

These are the following countries: Afghanistan, Brazil, Costa Rica, Cuba, Georgia, Iran, Pakistan, Russia, Suriname and Turkey.



OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION :

- o A **CURFEW** is in effect in Martinique, from **7:00 pm to 5:00 am**.
- o Restaurants and bars are open during the day. A **PROOF OF VACCINATION** is required for all persons entering these establishments.
